There is a change in the way FWP is handling our permit to use game birds while dog training. In the past they issued us a permit for the entire club. They will no longer do this, each individual that wishes to use game birds must have a permit.

I want to make sure everyone understands this. If you wish to use game birds for your dog/dogs you must apply for a permit to do so. Pigeons and quail are not considered game birds. You may utilize gunners to assist you under the terms of your permit but a gunner having a permit does not allow you to use gamebirds if you do not. FWP is allowing us to utilize game birds at the Horse Pasture portion of Missouri Headwaters State Park and the Blackbird Fishing Access Site.

We are enclosing a copy of the permit for you. This permit contains two parts. If you are going to hold game birds you must fill out part 1. If you are only going to use birds supplied by the club you do not need to fill out Part 1.

Part 2 is the portion you fill out to use game birds while training. The legal description for the Horse Pasture and Blackbird FAS are:

Horse Pasture: Township T2N, Range R2E, Sections 20 & 21

Blackbird: Township T2N, Range R2E, Section 19

For those that might use the Greycliffs Ranch, T1S, R1E, Section 8
