The Hunt Test location is located about three miles from Three Forks. Lunches will be available to purchase at the test area. Wheat Montana bakery is located at the junction of I-90 and highway 287 for snacks or breakfast. There is a café in Three Forks that serves a good breakfast. Three Forks has a full service grocery store.

*No smoking on the grounds. No alcoholic beverages until the event is over each day.
